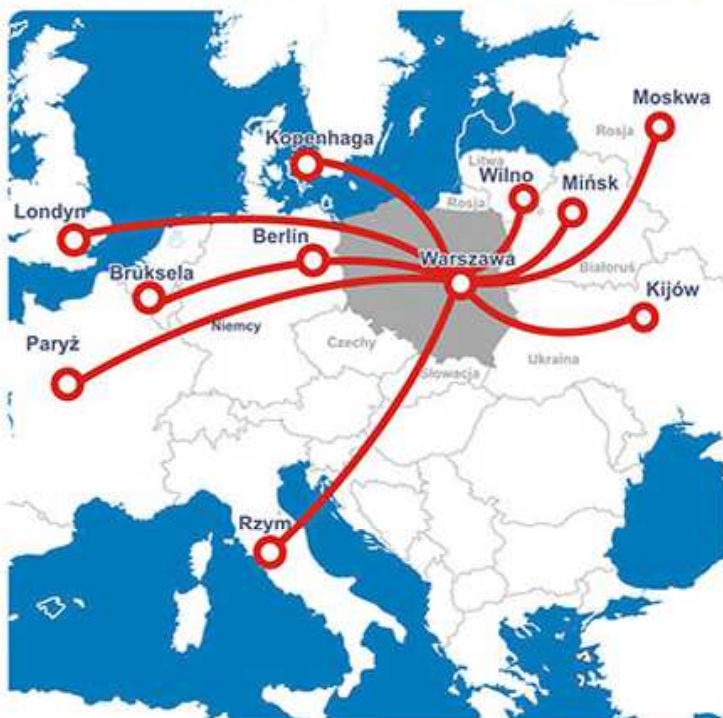


RADOM

- situated in the central part of Poland in the Mazovian Voivodship
- 100km away from Warsaw, 200 km from Cracow
- Warsaw airport accessible in an hour
- Three international and domestic routes connecting Gdansk, Warsaw, Rzeszow and Lublin

ECONOMIC POTENTIAL

The city has about 25,000 economic entities supported by a network of business assisting institutions. Ranked as the second important education centre in the Mazovian Voivodship, Radom offers 50% lower costs of living than the capital city.



AIR SHOW

Every second year International Air Show, thought to be the largest in this part of Europe, attracts thousands of aviation fans and enthusiasts of precision flying.



CULTURE

- Exhibitions and performances at "Łaźnia" Cultural Centre and Art Gallery, Resursa Obywatelska Art and Cultural Centre, "Elektrownia" Mazovian Centre for Contemporary Art, the Jacek Malczewski Museum, Radom Village Museum). Radom boasts one of the best in Poland collections of contemporary art and one of the four biggest national collection of works by Jacek Malczewski.
- Outdoor events related to the history and traditions of the city, including Street of Tradition, Medieval Historical Picnic, Anima Urbis - night tour of the city, battles reconstructions of the January Uprising and the Polish-Russian war.
- Concerts and music festivals: The Mikołaj of Radom International Early Music Festival, Radom Jazz Festival, a series of "Let's meet at Żeromski Street".
- Events associated with crops traditionally cultivated in the Radom area, such as cereals (Bread Festival) and potatoes (Potato Feast).



INTERNATIONAL GOMBROWICZ FESTIVAL

One of the most important theatre festivals in Poland held in Radom every second autumn and accompanied by numerous events comprising theatre, science, journalism, visual arts, music and film.



SCIENCE

Radom Science Picnic means unusual meetings with: chemistry, geography, automotive industry, biology, physics, electronics, cosmetology, mechanics, ecology, graphics, technology, photography, astronomy, forensic science and many other fields of science that are known, and those which are not known. In addition to dynamic demonstrations, interactive activities and exhibitions, participants can take part in various competitions. It is a compendium of knowledge and great fun not only for children but also for adults.

SELECTED EVENTS

Krzysztof Penderecki International Composers' Competition - Certamen Compositorum Internationale ARBORETUM. The competition is organized by Radom Chamber Orchestra. Composers from around the world take part in the competition.



"Intimate Summer" National Film Meetings - a project which is a combination of complex film workshops for young people (theoretical lectures and practical training courses), discussion panel, open film screening, film competitions and innovative forms of public education.

Radom Fashion Show - a nationwide competition for designers, addressed to enthusiasts and lovers of fashion, creating in this area. It is also a presentation of the latest fashion trends.
